

EXCLUSION FROM SCHOOL AND/OR SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

In compliance with due process procedures prescribed by the State, Student Rights and Responsibilities Policy, the following list of disciplinary infractions may be dealt with by exclusions from school and/or school activities.

1. Theft.
2. Possession of, use of, selling of or dispensing of tobacco, alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs or look-a-likes.
3. Disobedience, insubordination, or disrespect to those in authority.
4. Infractions of any of the approved, published regulations in the student handbook.
5. Vandalism - willful destruction of property.
6. Fighting, including the physical confronting, shoving, pushing, hitting or striking of person of another.
7. Use of profanity or any profanity directed to those in authority.
8. Unexcused absences, tardiness or cutting of classes.
9. Any interference with the education of fellow students.
10. Any infraction of Federal, State or local laws.
11. Weapons as designated in board policy and state and federal regulations.

Exclusion from the normal school setting may be in the form of in-school suspension, out-of-school suspension, and/or expulsion from school. Students will be given due process. Drug and Alcohol Policy #227 information and guidelines are available in respective building handbooks.
